



**Single Family Dwelling (Standard Fees)  
Township of Uxbridge**

**Effective January 2023 (Town)/November 2022 (Region)**

<b>Building Permit</b> - \$11.65m <sup>2</sup> of gross floor area of all floors except unfinished portions of basements in residential buildings, but including attached garages and underground parking areas.
<b>Plumbing Permit</b> – \$13.52 per fixtures; \$13.52 hot water tank; \$13.52 per sewer drain connection; and \$13.52 Interceptor, sump etc.
<b>Performance Bond Fee</b> – A \$1,000 performance bond fee shall be required for each new residential dwelling unit to be constructed. Said performance bond shall be refunded (without interest) to the permit holder provided the dwelling unit is completed within two (2) years of the date upon which the permit was issued.
