Introduction

Nestled in the rolling hills of the Oak Ridges Moraine, the Township of Uxbridge is home to over 20,000 residents and 1,900 businesses in diverse range of sectors from agriculture to professional services and advanced manufacturing. Uxbridge businesses attract talented employees from across the Greater Toronto Area, and hire graduates from our local colleges and universities. They market products locally and around the world with the ease of access to numerous transportation networks.



Life in Uxbridge is about community and celebrates arts, culture, heritage and recreation.

Uxbridge is home to some of Ontario's finest golf courses and ski facilities making the community truly a four season tourism destination. We have a thriving arts community supported by local theatre productions performed many weekends at Uxbridge's historical Music Hall. Art in the Park, Uxperience, Celebration of the Arts, and the Uxbridge Studio Tour are annual events promoting creativity in the physical, dance and musical arts. With over 220 kilometres of managed trails on over 8,000 acres of protected green space, Uxbridge is the Trail Capital of Canada.

We have well-developed health care system and a satellite location of Markham Stouffville Hospital, the Uxbridge Cottage Hospital. GO transit, Durham Region Transit and local, regional and provincial roads make for a reliable transportation system; diverse housing; a complete education system, inclusive of French immersion.

The Township of Uxbridge is one of eight municipalities in Durham Region, the largest geographic region in the Greater Toronto Golden Horseshoe area. The Township is governed by a seven member municipal council consisting of a mayor, regional councilor and five ward councillors. The municipality is responsible for fire protection, local by-laws and permits, local roads, municipal planning including site plan approvals and zoning, and recreation and culture. Police services, waste management, water and sewer services, social services, economic development and regional planning are handled by Durham Region.

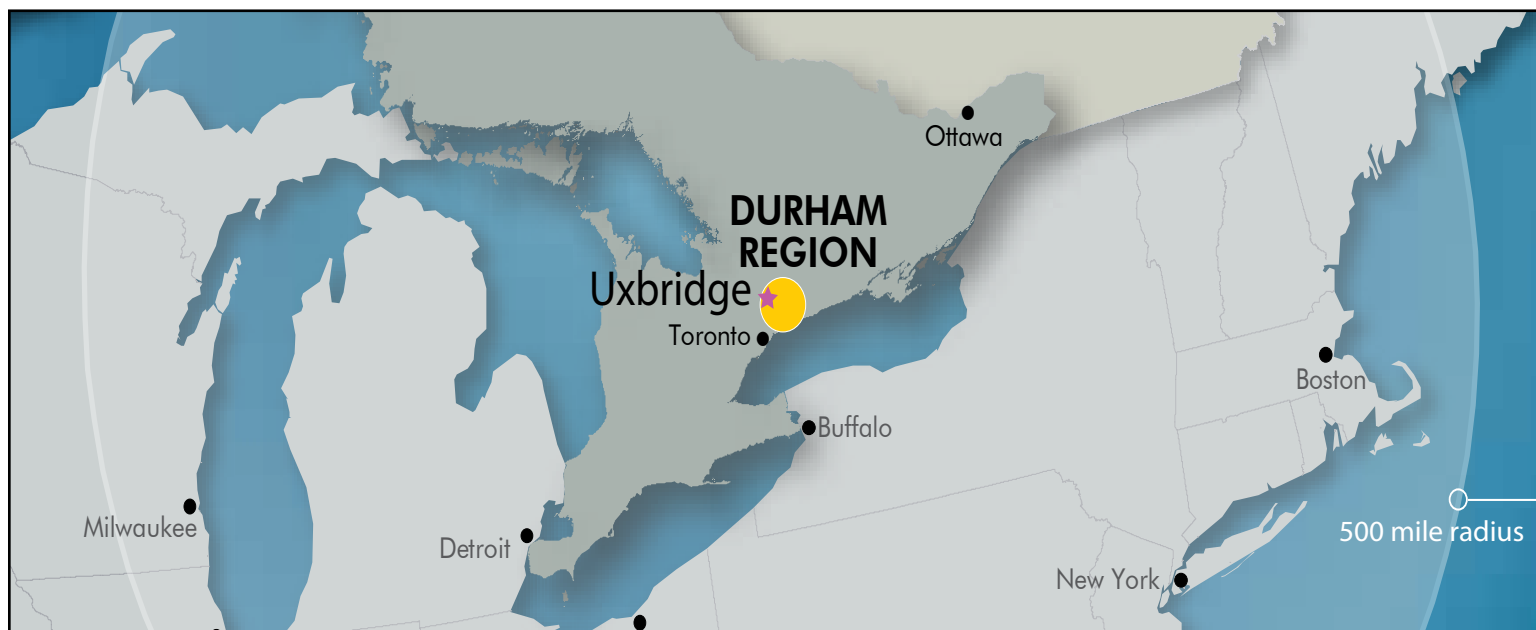

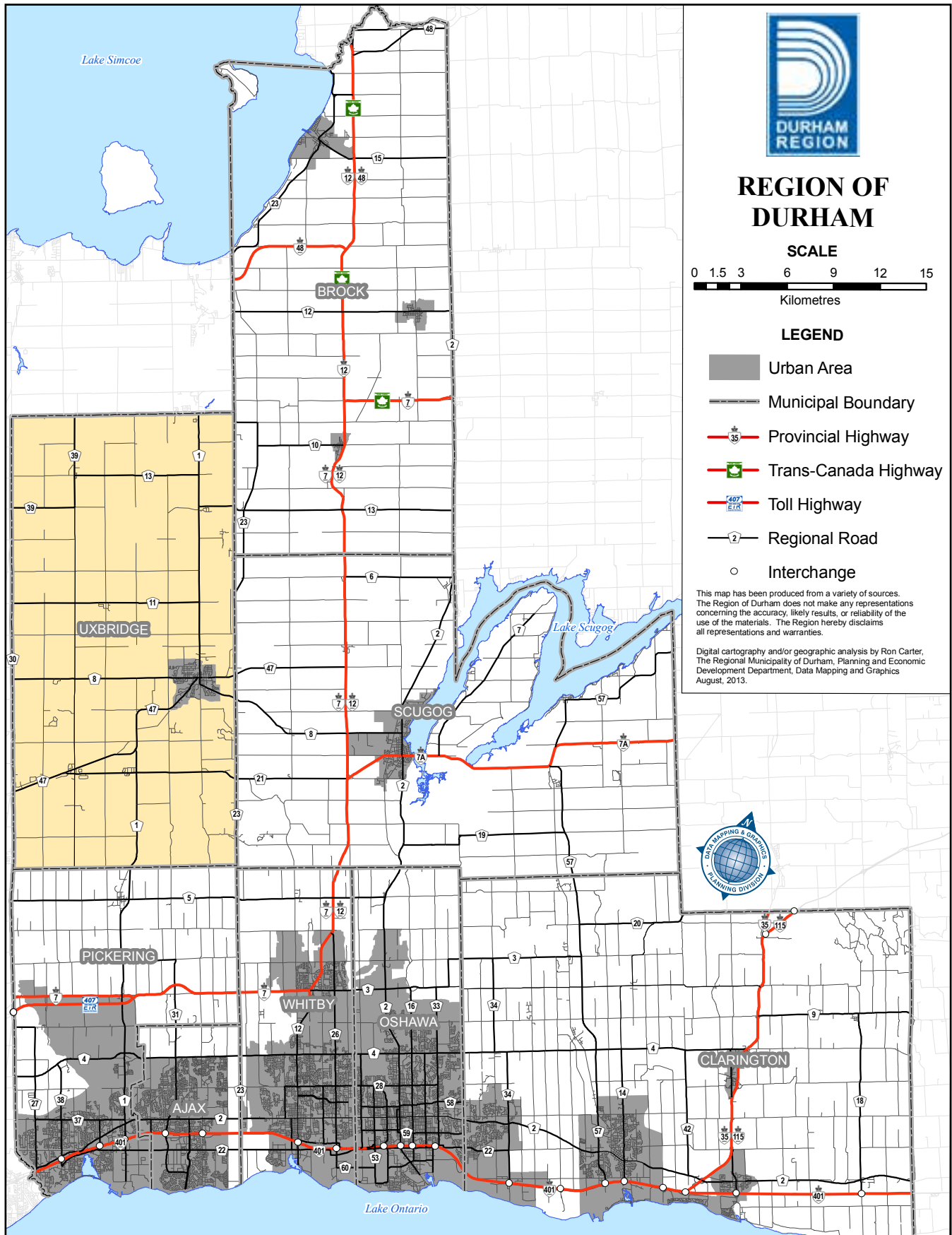

REGION OF DURHAM



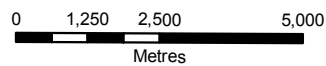

MAJOR ECONOMIC SECTORS

Industry

Industry is significant component of the local Uxbridge economy. Together, construction, manufacturing, wholesale, transportation and warehousing sectors employ 1,815 people representing over 20% total employment. Businesses in these sectors are located across the urban and rural areas of the Township. Clusters are found in the Uxbridge Industrial Park (Durham Road 30 and Durham Highway 47), Parrott Road Industrial park, and on side roads along Toronto Street South.

Aggregates

Aggregates are used in a diverse range of applications from construction to roads and airports. In 2012, the overall production of mineral aggregates in Ontario totalled approximately 152 million tonnes (TOARC, 2013). In 2013, Uxbridge was one of the top ten producing municipalities in Ontario producing over 3.6 million tonnes.

Agriculture

Agriculture is the largest primary goods producing sector in the Region. It is the largest economic driver in rural areas where products are diverse to serve a significantly growing market place. Uxbridge Township is well positioned to serve this marketplace into the future given proximity to larger City of Toronto market and transportation infrastructure.

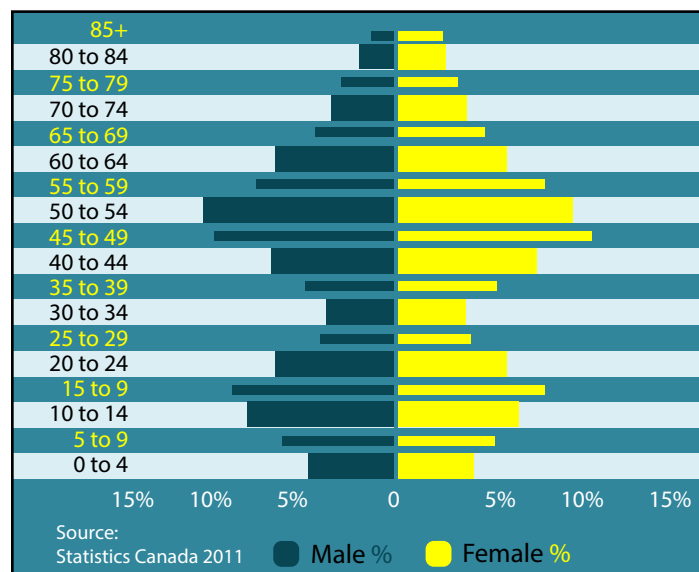

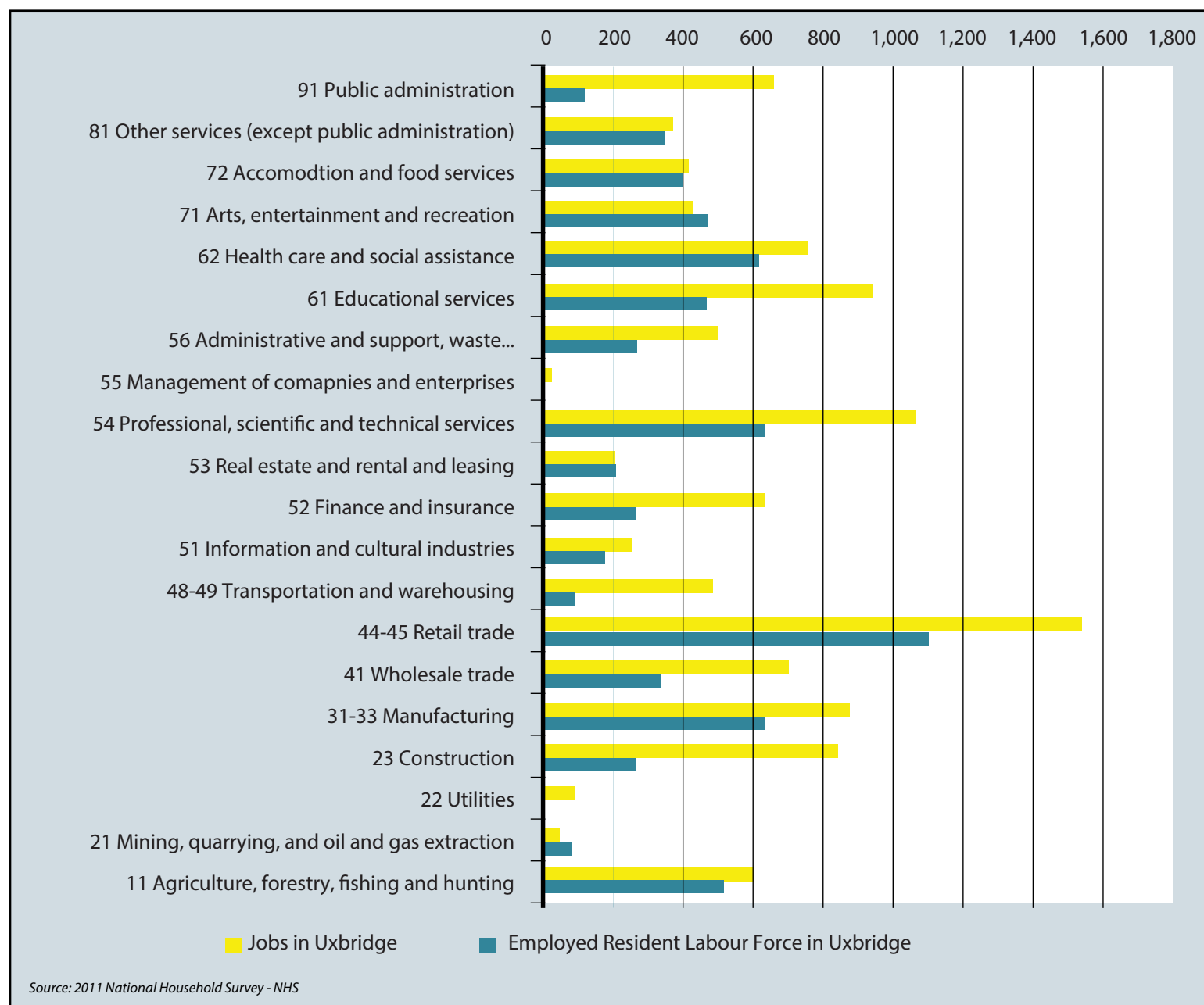

BUILDING PERMIT AND DEVELOPMENT CHARGES

The Township of Uxbridge is located in the Oak Ridges Moraine and Greenbelt which ensures the preservation of green space and environmental features. If you are looking to develop in Uxbridge, the Township has planning and building staff to help you through the process, including the option for a pre-consultation meeting.

Development Charges

New development generates capital costs which should be financed from this new development. Development charges are a viable capital funding source to recover the net costs of these

The water meter registers the amount of water passing through it. In order to calculate the amount of water to bill, subtract the current reading from the last billed reading. By applying the applicable water and sanitary sewer rates to the consumption used, and adding in the appropriate water and sanitary sewer service charges, the amount of the bill can be calculated.
