# Things to Know

## Contact Information

### Age of Participants

Our camp programs are designed and programmed for specific age groups. Participants must meet the minimum age requirement within the current calendar year (December 31, 2026) to participate in the camp program.

### Conduct

The Township of Uxbridge is proud to provide safe, secure, and welcoming environments for all participants and staff members. Coarse language, bullying, vandalism, physical or aggressive behaviour is strictly prohibited. Such activity will be recorded, reported, and may result in the removal from the camp and/or facility at the discretion of Management.

### Health and Safety

All campers with a medical concern(s) are required to complete a Medical Form prior to their first day of camp. Medical Forms can be found in the camp information package, which is emailed to the address on file prior to the first day of camp. If a participant has a communicable disease or a current public health concern, we kindly ask that they not attend camp during such time.

### Camp Information Packages

All camp specific program information (i.e. drop off/pick up locations, medical forms, permission to pick up forms, etc.) will be emailed to the email address associated with the camper's account before the start date. **Please ensure that your email address, emergency contacts, and camper medical and special request information is up to date during registration.** Should you have any further questions after reading the camp information package, please contact the appropriate camp provider.

### Allergy Awareness

To help ensure a safe camp environment, **peanut and nut products are not permitted** due to severe allergies among campers and staff. Other food allergies will be identified in the weekly camp information package. Please pack lunches with care and list all allergies on your camper's Medical Form. While we promote a peanut/nut-free environment, our shared facilities cannot be guaranteed to be allergen-free.

## **Sign In/Out Procedures**

Campers must be signed in and out with their Camp Supervisor by an authorized parent/guardian. A completed Permission to Pick Up form is required before the first day of camp and must list all approved pick-up persons. Photo ID will be required at pick-up. Any updates to authorized pick-ups must be communicated to your camper's Supervisor.

## **Late Fee Policy**

A \$5 late fee will apply for every five minutes after 4:30 p.m. (5:00 p.m. for Library Camps) that a camper has not been picked up and who is not registered for Extended Care. If available for your child's camp, please consider registering for PM Care, should you anticipate not being able to arrive on time for pick up.

## **Refund Policy**

- Cancellations made 15 days or more before the camp start date will receive a refund, less a \$25 administration fee per child, per camp, and can be processed on ActiveNet.
- Cancellations made 7-14 days in advance of the camp start date will receive a refund, less a \$50 administration fee per child, per camp, and must be submitted in writing to your camp provider.
- No refunds will be issued for cancellations made less than 7 days of the camp start date, except in cases of illness or extenuating circumstances, which may be reviewed at the discretion of the Municipality.

## **Refund Processing**

- Refunds will be issued to the original form of payment wherever possible.
- Refund requests submitted more than 15 days prior to the program start date may be processed by the registrant through their ActiveNet account (please select credit card refund, not a refund to your account).
- Refund requests made within 14 days of the program start date must be submitted directly to your camp provider in writing.

## **Waitlists**

All camp registrations are first-come, first-served, and availability may change as registrations are processed.

# UxCamps Specific Rules

## Camp Inclusion

If your child requires additional support to participate in camp, please notify the UxCamps team **before registration** to discuss accommodations. Requests for 1:1 support require an interview with staff to ensure we can meet your camper's needs. 1:1 support may be approved for a maximum of two (2) weeks of camp. Please note that UxCamps cannot accommodate complex needs (e.g., medical, behavioural, or physical).

If a camper requires 1:1 support that hasn't been arranged in advance, continued registration will depend on staff availability, and the Recreation Department may withdraw the camper's registration if adequate support cannot be provided.

Please ensure your email address, emergency contacts, and camper medical or special request information are up to date in our system at the time of registration.

**Note:** 1:1 support is only available for UxCamps. Museum and Library camps cannot provide this support.

## Swim Tests

Campers will have the opportunity to participate in free swim at least once per week. A swim test may be required depending on a camper's age and desired swim area. Swim tests are required for campers who wish to swim in the middle or deep end, or for campers over age six who wish to swim in the shallow end without a life jacket.

Swim tests are administered and assessed by lifeguards and may result in full, partial, or shallow-end-only pool access. Campers aged six and under must wear a life jacket and are not required to complete a swim test, in accordance with Uxpool policy.

## Extended Care

AM Care is available for select camps at Elgin Park, with drop-off between 7:30–8:30 a.m. PM Care is available for select camps at Bonner Fields, with pick-up between 4:30–5:30 p.m.; late fees apply after 5:30 p.m. Campers are not supervised outside of these hours. Please refer to the camp-specific page for AM/PM Care availability.
