Complete rows in any direction on the **Uxbridge Bike Month Bingo Card** between **June 1 and June 30, 2022** to be eligible to win a prize! Prizes to be won by submitting up to five (5) photos per person showing your participation in a different bingo square activity from your completed row(s). No purchase necessary. Each submitted photo counts as one entry in the prize draw. <u>Entries can be emailed to info@uxbridge.ca with subject line "Bike Month Bingo"</u>. Participants 17 years of age and under will be eligible to win a prize. Contest winners will be chosen by random from submitted entries. **REGISTRATION NOT REQUIRED!**

Bike Month Photo Contest Rules:

- The contest is open to youth age 17 or younger, and who must be visible in the photos. Photos may be taken and submitted by an adult. Photos can also include people older than 17 but will only be considered for a prize when youth are present.
- Photographs must be taken between June 1st and June 30, 2022. Photos submitted after June 30, 2022 will not be eligible for entry.
 To enter contest, email photos to <u>info@uxbridge.ca</u> No purchase is necessary to enter the contest.
- Up to five (5) unique photo entries per person will be accepted for completing different squares on the bingo card. Each submitted photo counts as one (1) entry in the prize draw.
- Contest winners will be chosen by random from submitted entries. Once an entry has won, it will be removed from the pool of future candidates.
- By participating in this contest, each entrant agrees to provide the Township of Uxbridge with the non-exclusive rights to use their images for future use. Participants agree to the terms and conditions outlined in this contest.
- Any entry that displays symbols of hate, inappropriate language, offensive or abusive comments, or any behaviour that contravenes the spirit and objectives of the Township's Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (EDI) blueprint, is strictly prohibited. Entries displaying this type of behaviour will be immediately reported and disqualified from the Contest.
- Contest prizes must be accepted as awarded and are not transferable, redeemable, refundable, or exchangeable for cash and not replaceable if lost/stolen.
