


Combination of tax rates from the Region of Durham, Township of Uxbridge and Province (Education)




2022 Regional Property Taxes – Average Home





2022 Property Taxes by Property Classification




Average Monthly Cost of Services* provided by the Township Per Household

(per 2022 Approved Budget, based on ave. assessed value of \$600k)




Total Township Asset Values by Category (as of Dec. 31, 2020)



Asset Preservation

Province legislates that municipalities develop an <u>Asset Management Plan</u> (AMP) for core infrastructure assets. The Township applies a levy each year to fund asset preservation.






2022 Total Township Revenues and Expenditures Budgets



Operating Grants 2013-2022




Sources of Capital Grants 2013-2022
