



TOWNSHIP OF UXBRIDGE

MOTORIZED SNOW VEHICLE BY-LAW

INFORMATION GUIDE FOR

By-law No. 2010-037



WHERE YOU CAN'T RIDE

Under this by-law, motorized snow vehicles (MSVs) may not be operated:

- On Township roads unless the driver is licensed under the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act.
- On sidewalks, except to cross at a 90-degree angle.
- In public parks, unless approved as part of a special event authorized by Council.
- On sidewalks within parks, at any time.
- At speeds above:
 - 20km/h where posted speed is 50km/h or less.
 - 50km/h where posted speed is more than 50km/h.
- In any hamlet or urban area of Uxbridge between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.



RULES YOU MUST FOLLOW

- Your vehicle must have a properly functioning muffler (no bypass, cut-outs, or straight pipes).
- You must carry a valid MSV license.
- Owners are responsible for vehicles operated in violation – unless proven otherwise.
- All laws under the Motorized Snow vehicles Act and Highway Traffic Act also apply.

ENFORCEMENT & FINES

- This by-law is enforced by:
 - Uxbridge Municipal Law Enforcement Officers.
 - Police Officers.
- Violations may result in fines under the Provincial Offences Act.

EXCEPTIONS

- This by-law does not apply to:
- Police officers operating an MSV during official duties.
- Emergency use on roads closed due to snow or ice.
