

WHO IS RESPONSIBLE?

If you own or occupy a property in the Township of Uxbridge-- whether it is residential, commercial, vacant, or occupied-- you are responsible for clearing snow, slush, and ice:

- From sidewalks adjacent to your property.
- From the roof of any building that is adjacent to a sidewalk or Township property.



Snow removal must be done within 24 hours after the end of a snowfall or ice accumulation.

WHAT YOU CANNOT DO

To help keep everyone safe and avoid penalties:

- Don't push or pile snow/slush/ice onto any road or sidewalk.
- Don't block fire hydrants.
- Don't damage curbs or sidewalks while clearing snow.
- Don't make the sidewalk unsafe for pedestrians.

Violating any of these rules may result in fines and charges for snow removal.

WHAT IF I DON'T COMPLY?



If sidewalks aren't cleared within 24 hours:

- The Township may remove the snow/ice and charge the property owner or occupant for:
 - The cost of removal.
 - A 25% administration fee.
- These charges may be added to your property tax bill.

SAFETY **REMINDER**

Blocked sidewalks and icy roofs can lead to:

- Slips and fall injuries.
- Legal liability.
- Delays for emergency services and pedestrians.

Let's work together to keep our community safe and walkable!





- Shovel early and often during snowfalls.
- Use salt or sand to reduce ice.
- Don't forget to check the roof if snow buildup is visible.
