CIVIL MARRIAGE CEREMONY # 1A - Short

Officiant:

This couple has come here today to be joined in marriage, which is the voluntary union of two persons to the exclusion of all others. If any person can show just cause why they may not be lawfully joined together, let them speak now or forever hold their peace.

Officiant to Celebrant 1: Please repeat after me.

"I, , do solemnly declare / that I do not know / of any lawful impediment / why I may not be joined in matrimony / to Celebrant 2."

Officiant to Celebrant 2: Please repeat after me.

"I, Celebrant 2, do solemnly declare / that I do not know / of any lawful impediment / why I may not be joined in matrimony / to Celebrant 1"

Officiant to Celebrant 1: Please repeat after me.

"I call upon these persons here present / to witness that I, Celebrant 1, / do take you, Celebrant 2, / to be my lawful wedded wife."

Officiant to Celebrant 2: Please repeat after me.

"I call upon these persons here present / to witness that I, Celebrant 2, / do take you, Celebrant 1, / to be my lawful wedded husband."

Officiant:

I, *Officiant*, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Marriage Act, do hereby pronounce you Celebrant 1 and Celebrant 2 to be married.

May you enjoy length of days, fulfillment of hopes and peace and contentment of mind, as you day by day live and fulfill the terms of this covenant you have made with one another. You may have your first married kiss.
