## Mayor Dave's Video:

#### Updates from Council:

#### Mayor, Dave Barton:

## Regional Councillor, Bruce Garrod:

The number one regional investment on many people's minds is Regional Road improvements. Here is a list of road projects and their progress:

- Regional Rd 1, toward Leaskdale, is almost complete.
- **Regional Hwy 47**, **west of Goodwood**, is currently being resurfaced, with speed limit adjustments to follow.
- Durham 8, near Mill Run golf course, is now closed for a bridge rebuild.
  - Check out the video of Mayor Dave on his Facebook page, where he stands under this bridge, highlighting the importance of these repairs.
- Sandford Rd will soon see paved shoulders added.
- **Zephyr Rd** work is currently being scheduled and will soon be finalized by Regional staff.

In all, there are 11 regional road improvements taking place this year.

One of my favourite subjects, Durham Transit, continues to report record ridership. The most recent report I received shows total boardings in Uxbridge are up 12.5% year-todate. Residents are always surprised when I share data such as that there were 2,249 riders in May on the 605 bus that loops around the urban area. That's 300 more than the previous record! Over 1000 people rode the 905 bus and 1458 took advantage of ondemand service (another record!).

I've previously commented on my eye-opening experience of sitting with the incredible staff who take 911 calls. In July, I am going to sit with the crew that specifically manages calls for EMS support. I'll report back on what I learn.

Summer has officially arrived. I hope all residents have a safe, fun and relaxing summer. Enjoy!

# Hospital Ground Breaking:

The construction process for the new hospital upgrades and long-term care facility has officially begun!

On Tuesday, June 10, 2025, Township officials were joined by our local Member of Provincial Parliament, Peter Bethlenfalvy, and Deputy Premier and Minister of Health, Sylvia Jones, to mark the start of construction on the new healthcare facility.

Planned upgrades include a modern 192-bed long-term care home, 11 additional beds for patient care, and expanded services such as diagnostic imaging, cardiorespiratory care, and pharmacy services.

These improvements are made possible thanks to an additional \$8.9 million in provincial funding provided to Oak Valley Health Uxbridge Hospital for the redevelopment and expansion of its facilities.

This exciting milestone signals transformative changes in the delivery of healthcare services in Uxbridge.

- At Your Bank: Payments can be made at most banks and trust companies.
